Duties of the R2

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Checking the Line-up

- **Use lineup card to verify players are in their proper positions (receiving team first)**
- **Signals the libero (if used) to enter the court**
- **Indicates the floor captain to the first referee.**
- **Follows the same procedure for the serving team.**

Checking the Line-up

- **Take the game ball from the table, rolls it to the server,**
- **Check that the scorer and libero tracker are ready,**
- **Take a position on the receiving side of the net and**
- **Give the ready to play signal to the first referee.**

Transitioning During the Match

- **Focus on the center line and net area**
- **Transition to be positioned on the blocking side of the net**

Assist with Ball-handling Violations

- **Only when they are clearly out of the first referee's view**
- **Informal signals should be used**
- **How these calls are to be communicated and addressed in the referee's pre-match conference**

Net Fault

- **Whistle, move to the side of the net of the offending team, signal the fault.**
- **Net fault - indicates the number of the offending player**
- **First referee indicates the result of the play, then displays the number of the offending player**
- **Second referee mirrors the result of the play signal - does not display the number of the offending player**

Center line Violation

- **Player touches the floor completely across the center line without part of the hand/hands or foot/feet remaining on or above the center line**
- **Player contacts the floor across the center line with any part of the body other than the hand/hands or foot/feet**

Substitution Procedure

- **Coach visually signals a request or substitute enters the sub zone**
- **Request is recognized with two short whistles and Signal 15**
- **Sub enters the court, using Signal 16 reports to the scorer and libero tracker and records on the lineup card**
- **Returns to the position and gives the ready-to-play signal to the first referee**

Time Out Procedure

- **Request is recognized with two short whistles and Signal 19**
- **Indicate to the first referee number of time-outs each team has used**
- **Remind timer to start the clock**
- **Check that the time-out is recorded**
- **Check individual score and team score**

Time Out Procedure

- **Confirm status of the libero (on or off the court)**
- **45 seconds have elapsed (15)-
double whistle**
- **60 seconds, the timer sound the
horn to end the time-out**
- **Indicate the number of time-outs
used**

Time Out Procedure

- **Inform the coach if two time-outs are used**
- **Give the ready-to-play signal to the first referee**
- **If both teams are ready to play prior to the 60 seconds, the second referee instructs the timer to stop the clock, the second referee blows two short blasts. The timer will then sound the horn to end the time out.**

Coin Toss for Deciding Set

- **Prior to the deciding set, both teams shall send a captain to the official's table area for the coin toss conducted by the second referee.**
- **The home team captain calls the coin toss.**
- **The winner of the toss chooses one of the following: to serve/receive, or which court to occupy.**
- **The other team gets the remaining choice.**
